

- a) European Union tour guides in the exercise of their professional activity, upon presentation of a valid license issued by the competent authority;
- b) European Union tourist interpreters when their services are required alongside a tour guide, upon presentation of a valid license issued by the competent authority;
- c) Ministry personnel;
- d) Members of the ICOM (International Council of Museums);
- e) Visitors under the age of eighteen. Visitors under twelve years old must be accompanied;
- f) Groups or student groups from public and private schools of the European Union, accompanied by their teachers, by prior reservation and within the limits set by the institute's or cultural site's director;
- g) Professors and students enrolled in faculties of architecture, cultural heritage preservation, education sciences, or degree courses in humanities or literary subjects with an archaeological or historical-artistic focus within the faculties of humanities and philosophy, or in corresponding faculties and courses established in the member states of the European Union. Free admission is granted to students upon presentation of the certificate of enrollment for the current academic year;
- h) Professors and students enrolled in fine arts academies or corresponding institutions of the European Union. Free admission is granted to students upon presentation of the certificate of enrollment for the current academic year;
- h-bis) Teaching staff of schools, whether permanent or on fixed-term contracts, upon presentation of suitable certification issued by the educational institutions, without any new or additional financial burden on public finances, according to the model provided by the Ministry of Education, University, and Research;
- i) People with disabilities and one family member or another caregiver who demonstrates their affiliation with social and healthcare assistance services;
- l) Volunteers from associations that, based on existing agreements concluded with the Ministry in accordance with Article 112, paragraph 8 of the Code, carry out activities to promote and disseminate knowledge of cultural heritage.
